

Electric Resale of Third Party Licenses

Electric may resell and provide or otherwise make accessible to Customer certain Purchased Third Party Software that is owned by third parties (“Third Party Software Providers”), the use of which may be subject to additional or different terms set forth in the applicable license (“Third Party Licenses”).

Customer acknowledges that Purchased Third Party Software from Google or Microsoft must be purchased through Electric as a reseller, in order for Customer to receive Google or Microsoft application administration and support as detailed in Electric’s scope of services.

Additional resales of or access to a particular piece of Purchased Third Party Software (including but not limited to adding users and/or seats) under the existing license between Customer and such Third Party Software Provider in the course of provisioning additional Customer end-users shall not require an additional Order Form and Customer will be charged automatically for any such additional users and/or seats without the requirement of an additional invoice. Customer authorizations for the purchase of additional Third Party Software licenses are obtained by Electric as outlined below.

Procurement Authorization for Third Party Licenses

Slack/Teams Approval

If a request for procurement of a new license is submitted via Slack or Teams to Electric, the Electric team will verify if the requestor is designated as an Approver (a person with established authority to authorize license procurements). If the person is verified as an Approver, the initial request for procurement via Slack or Teams will suffice as authorization to procure the requested license. If it is verified that the requestor is not an Approver, the Electric team will route the request to a designated Approver within the requestor’s organization, to obtain written approval via Slack or Teams to procure the license. The aforementioned written approval via Slack or Teams will suffice as authorization to procure the requested license.

Onboarding Submission via Turbine

If a request for procurement of a new license is associated with an onboarding request submitted via Turbine, the submission of the onboarding request will suffice as authorization to procure the requested license. The customer agrees that any person with access to submit an onboarding request via Turbine, has the authority to procure new licenses in association with that onboarding request.
